NOTICE OF PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO RULE NO. 14.1
VOLUNTARY WATER CONSERVATION PLAN
Advice Letter No. 373
All Districts

By Advice Letter 373, Del Oro Water Company (DOWC), on behalf of all of its districts, has requested authority from the CALIFORNIA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION (CPUC) to update and/or modify its current Rule No. 14.1, Voluntary Water Conservation Plan in accordance with CPUC Resolution No. W-4976, dated February 28, 2014, which puts forth Drought Procedures for Water Conservation, Rationing and Service Connection Moratoria.

DOWC's current Voluntary Conservation Rule No. 14.1 remains in effect and a new conservation measure, suggested by the CPUC, is: *Operation of commercial car washes without recycling at least 50% of the potable water used per cycle.*

THE CURRENT RULES (*OTHER SIDE*) ARE BEING ACTIVATED IMMEDIATELY, MINUS THE PENDING ADDITION.

There are two ways to respond to this notice. You may send a protest to the CPUC and, if you do, you must send a copy of the protest to DOWC, or you can send a response to the CPUC.

Protest and Responses:

A protest is a document objecting to the granting in whole or in part of the authority sought in this advice letter filing. A response is a document that does not object to the authority sought, but nevertheless presents information that the party tendering the response believes would be useful to the CPUC in acting on the request.

A protest must be mailed within 20 days of the date of this notice. A protest must state the facts constituting the grounds for the protest, the effect that approval of the advice letter might have on the protestant and the reasons the protestant believes the advice letter or part of it is not justified. If the protest requests an evidentiary hearing, the protest must state the facts the protestant would present at an evidentiary hearing to support its request for whole or partial denial of the advice letter.
