Advice Letter No. 270-A

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Del Oro Water Company, Inc. (DOWC) hereby transmits this Advice Letter No. 270-A for filing on behalf of its Arbuckle (DOWCAR), Ferndale (DOWCFD), Magalia (DOWCMD), Pine Flat (DOWCPF), Pine Mountain (DOWCPM), River Island (DOWCRI), and Walnut Ranch (DOWCWR) Districts. DOWC has been tracking the revenue from the surcharge in the Water Quality Balancing Account as required by Penal Code 792.5. This Supplemental Advice Letter includes the required tariff sheet numbering following California Public Utilities Commission Staff approval. 

ARBUCKLE DISTRICT

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 5. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth in Schedule No. UF.
- 6. A late charge will be imposed per Schedule No. LC
- 7. In accordance with Section 2714 of the Public Utilities Code, if a tenant in a rental unit leaves owing the company, service to subsequent tenants in that unit will, at the company's option, be furnished on the account of the landlord or property owner.
- 8. Per Advice Letter No. 236 dated July 7, 2009, granting an Interim Rate Increase and Resolution No. W-4805, dated December 3, 2009, granting a General rate Increase, under-collected revenues amounting to \$5,517.60 from July 7, 2009 through December 3, 2009 are imposed in a one-time surcharge of \$104.11 over approximately twenty-four (24) billing cycles at \$4.34 per month to each customer's bill upon approval by the California Public Utilities Commission. If over-collection of funds occurs, a credit will be issued to the customers.
- 9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission all bills are subject to a one-time Surcharge of \$6.11 billed over approximately three (3) billing cycles at \$2.04 per month to each customer's bill upon approval by the California Public Utilities Commission of Advice Letter No. 268. This charge offsets the California Department of Public Health fees as billed to the Arbutle District for Fiscal Year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.
- 10. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission all bills are subject to a one-time Surcharge of \$4.02 billed at \$1.34 over approximately three (3) billing cycles upon approval of Advice Letter No. 270. This charge offsets the expenses resulting from the Environmental Protection Agency's adopted National Primary Drinking Water Regulations for water testing for the period January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009.

RESIDENTIAL METERED SERVICE

ARBUCKLE DISTRICT

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

4. The annual service charge applies to service during the 12 month period commencing January 1 and is due in advance. If a permanent resident of the area has been a customer of the utility for at least 12 months, the resident may elect, at the beginning of the calendar year, to pay prorated service charges in advance at intervals of less than one year in accordance with the utility's established billing periods.
5. The established billing cycle for water used is monthly.
6. The opening bill for metered service, except upon conversion from flat rate service, shall be established after the first day of any year, the portion of such annual charge applicable to the current year shall be determined by multiplying the annual charge by one three-hundred-sixty-fifth (1/365) of the number of days remaining in the calendar year. The balance of the payment of the initial charge shall be credited against the charges for the succeeding annual period. If service is not continued for at least one year after the date of initial service, no refund of the initial annual charges shall be due the customer.
7. Per Advice Letter No. 236 dated July 7, 2009, granting an Interim Rate Increase and Resolution No. W-4805, dated December 3, 2009, granting a General rate Increase, under-collected revenues amounting to \$5,517.60 from July 7, 2009 through December 3, 2009 are imposed in a one-time surcharge of \$104.11 over approximately twenty-four (24) billing cycles at \$4.34 per month to each customer's bill upon approval by the California Public Utilities Commission.
